1	Best Idea	To build a communication platform between residents and Residents Committees in the OS App, such as a shared blog for each neighbourhood and to include voluntary checklists and surveys for residents. For example, the "Fight Dengue" checklist. To also introduce a digital badge reward system for completing such surveys/checklists or for attending community activities. 2	Great Idea	To introduce a micro-job crowdsourcing platform where the community can volunteer and earn points. These "jobs" can include HDB asking volunteers to report on the state of rubbish bins at pre-defined hours, or residents helping one another to move heavy furniture to the HDB central bin centre. 7	Great Idea	To enable more issues to be solved by the community rather than by the authorities, by allowing OS App users to communicate directly with others within their estates/blocks, as well as enabling Grassroots Leaders to view and address cases or mediate between neighbours if necessary.
